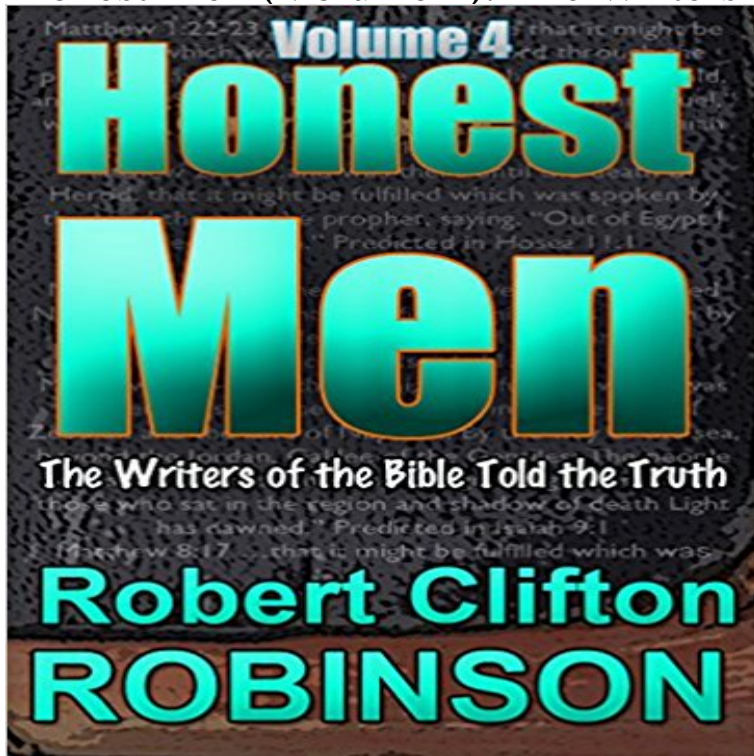


Honest Men (Volume 4): The Writers of the Bible Told the Truth

The Gospel of Jesus Christ is unique in that it claims to have the power to change a person from the inside-out. This is accomplished by a supernatural work of God, and not by man. When any person receives Jesus as their Savior, He comes to take residence inside the heart of this person. As a result, these individuals become a new creation, the old things pass away and all things become

new. Because the heart has changed, the behavior changes. As Jesus begins to live His life through us, we become more and more like Him. The problem for many people who experience this new spiritual birth, is their surprise when they discover that they will still sin. There will always be a battle between our flesh and the Spirit. From the moment that a person begins their new relationship with Jesus, there will be a struggle between our old nature and the new. The difference is that we no longer love to sin as we used to; instead we love to please the Lord. When we sin and we confess our transgressions to the Lord, He quickly forgives us and we go on in our close relationship with Him. In order for this new Spiritual birth to be possible, it will take more than a twelve step program; we will have to become new creatures. Only the Lord can accomplish such an impossible work. For this, we need a supernatural Savior, one who has the power to change us. This kind of Savior must be perfect and greater than all of our struggles. If there will be a Savior for mankind, He must be perfect and without sin; otherwise, how could one sinner save another sinner, it would be impossible. This Savior must also be one who is like us; a human being. The Bible makes it clear that only a close relative; a kinsman redeemer, can act as our mediator and bring us to God. Many people do not realize that the story of the prodigal son, taught by Jesus in the gospel of Luke, Chapter 15:11-32, most likely came from the illustration of redemption found in the Book of Ruth. Because Jesus determined to leave heaven and become one of us, every person has the ability to live in the perfection and beauty of heaven, forever.
