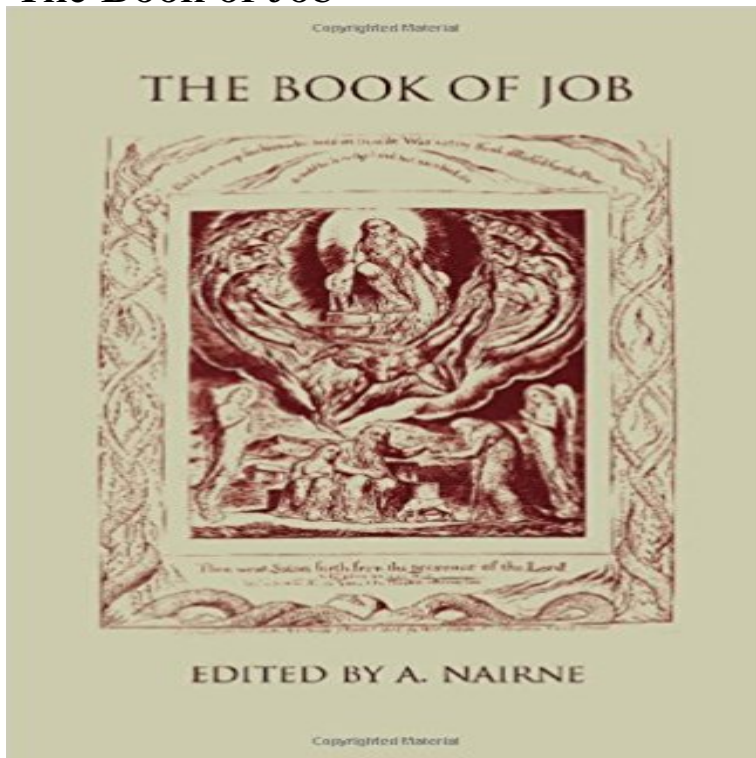


The Book of Job
