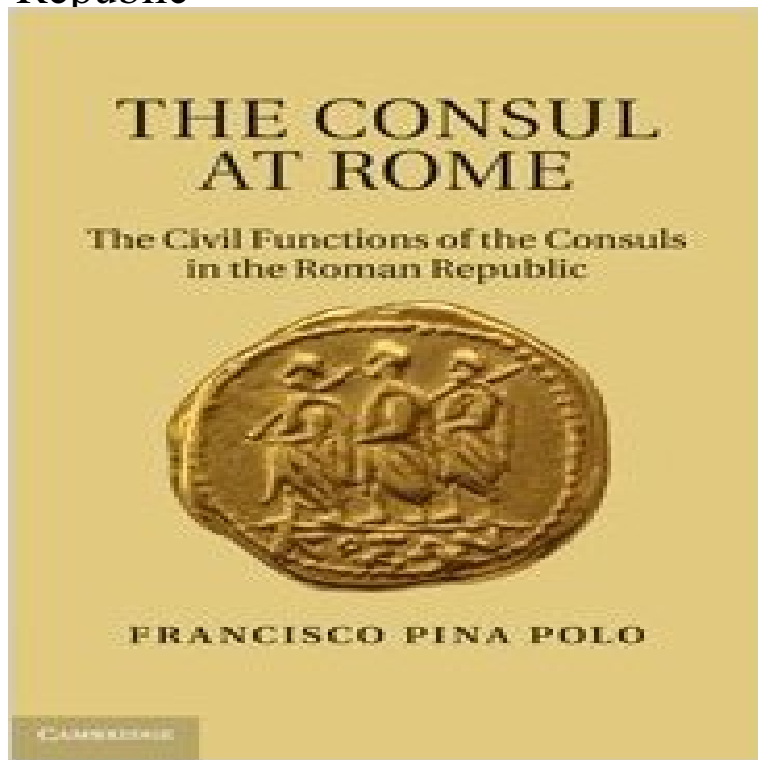


The Consul at Rome: The Civil Functions of the Consuls in the Roman Republic

Clearly and accessibly written, it will provide an indispensable reference work for all scholars and students of the history of the Roman Republic.
