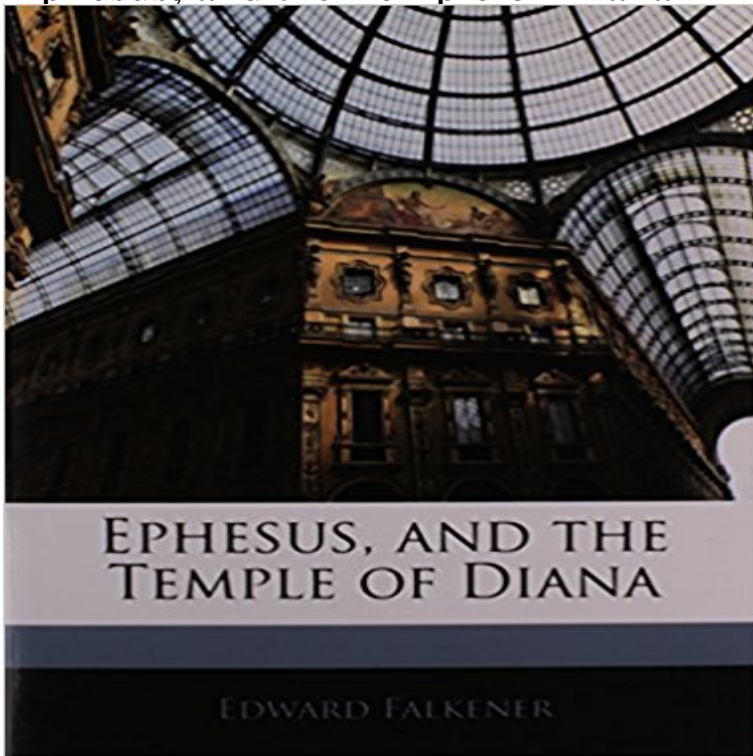


Ephesus, and the Temple of Diana
